The County of San Diego approved expanding McClellan-Palomar from a *small airplane (B-II)* airport to a *large jet (D-III)* airport.

24/7 Operating Hours ( <b>Voluntary Quiet Hours</b> – No penalties)	<b>Mandatory Quiet Hours:</b> 11pm – 7am

Just like John Wayne, a longer Runway WILL MEAN MORE Larger and Louder Planes.  
But unlike John Wayne - the FAA mandates McClellan-Palomar stay OPEN 24/7 with NO CURFEW!
